Lawn to Habitat applications open!

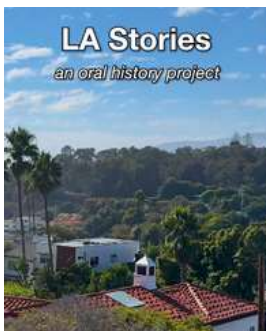
